International Fisheries Conference on Challenges and Opportunities for Sustainable Fisheries and Aquaculture Development (COSFAD, 2019): A Brief Report

This is the first International Conference held with respect to Fisheries and Aquaculture in Maharashtra in recent years.

In the keynote address Dr. Martin Santha Kumar discussed "Fisheries and Aquaculture for Food Security and Nutrition: Global and Indian Perspective", Dr. J. K. Jena spoke on "New Paradigms in Indian Aquaculture: Happiness, Health and Hope", Dr. S. Felix enlightened about "Need for Advancements and Advocacies in Indian Aquaculture" while Dr. Gopal Krishna presented the scenario of higher fisheries education in India.

Total 34 lead lectures, 41 papers and 82 posters were presented by the scientists under eleven major themes namely; Fishbiology and Fisheries Management, Ecology and Aquatic Biodiversity, Fisheries Administration and Policies, Advancement in Seed Production Systems, Nutrition and Feeding Practices, Sustainable Production Systems, Health and Environment Management, Advances in Harvest Technologies, Recent Trends in Aquatic Product Processing, Fisheries Economics and World Trade, Fisheries Extension and Capacity Building. Besides, there were special sessions for Fish/Shrimp farmers, Aqua farmers and Fisheries entrepreneurs.

On the occasion of the International Conference, a Souvenir containing 44 lead paper abstracts was released along with the 'Book of Abstracts'.

The conference was concluded with Plenary session in which 36 recommendations were presented and discussed thoroughly. These recommendations have been submitted to Government Agencies to frame the specific policies for sustainable fisheries and aquaculture development in India to overcome the present challenges and to grab the future opportunities in sustainable manner.
